### Topic: Prosthodontic Rehabilitation of the Head and Neck Cancer Patients : An Overview

Surgical ablation and oncologic treatments of head and neck cancers may result in defects that affect speech, mastication, swallowing and appearance in patients. Advances in surgical reconstruction and improvement in prosthodontic techniques have reduced some of these disabilities, but elimination and resolution for full functional rehabilitation has remained elusive for some of these patients. A team approach is necessary if optimum levels of rehabilitation are to be achieved. This presentation will provide an overview of issues and challenges pertaining to successful prosthodontic rehabilitation in this unique group of patients.

### Topic: 'My patients drive me up the walls' – Psychiatric aspects of Dental Practice

Patients come in all shapes and sizes – so they also have varied expectations and personalities; some may also have other mental health problems. Some patients are always anxious and some terrified just stepping into a dental clinic. From restless kids to the senile patient, from histrionic ladies to the mentally-challenged psychotic, we hope to understand each of them better and still able to deliver optimal dental care.

## Dr. Ang Chee Wan

Graduated with a Bachelor of Dental Surgery from the National University of Singapore.

Graduated with a Master of Dental Surgery degree from NUS

Obtained his fellowship in periodontology from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (United Kingdom). Dr Ang is an accredited specialist in periodontology registered with the Singapore Dental Council. He is a visiting specialist at the Singapore Armed Forces and the National University Hospital.



### **Topic: Advances in Periodontology: From Salvaging Teeth to Enhancing Teeth**

Two areas of dentistry have received significant attention in recent years. Implant dentistry and aesthetic dentistry have changed the way dentists practise over the past two decades. Consequently, periodontology has evolved from conventional scaling and root planning to fine surgical techniques to enhance aesthetics. However, many traditional principles and techniques remain relevant in both salvaging teeth and enhancing teeth. This lecture will relook at the basis of periodontal disease and the treatment options available to manage periodontal disease. The lecture will also present a simple system to aid general dentists and specialists in the management of periodontal disease. In addition, various advances in periodontology to enhance aesthetics will be discussed.

### **Topic: Maintaining a Healthy Periodontium around Dental Implants**

Implants are not a fit-and-forget modality of dental treatment. Despite the high success rate of dental implants, peri-implant tissues are subject to inflammatory lesions similar to those that occur to the natural dentition. Proper maintenance of implants as well as the prosthetic interface can tilt the balance of treatment outcome towards success or failure. The micro-flora contained in oral biofilms around dental implants play a key role in determining the health of the periodontium around dental implants and the supported prostheses. Current evidence sheds light on the microbiological components associated with plaque around dental implants, and the speaker will share his personal experience in the use of simple aids as therapeutic agents in the maintenance of healthy periodontium around dental implants.

### **Topic: Adult Orthodontics - Beyond The Envelope Of Discrepancy**

An overview of how adult orthodontics has evolved over the past 3 decades will be presented including surgical orthodontics. Advances in orthodontic appliance therapy have pushed the boundaries of orthodontics for the adult population. More complex treatments are achievable with good outcomes. Treatment needs are patient driven as more aesthetic alternative forms of braces are made available. Corrective jaw surgery is more sought after along with other aesthetic rejuvenating treatment procedures.

Dr Hong received his Bachelor and Master of Dental Surgery (Orthodontics) from NUS in 1989 and 1994 respectively. He was the pioneer batch of Orthodontic graduates from NUS. He runs Orthodontic private practices both in Malaysia and Singapore. He was Past Chairman of MDASZ and Chairperson of the Chapter of Orthodontists, College of Dental Surgeons, Academy of Medicine Singapore. Currently he holds the Chairperson post of the Dental Specialist Accreditation Committee (Orthodontics) in Singapore.



### **Title: Selection Of Teeth For Extraction In Orthodontic Treatment.**

A number of factors need to be considered when determining whether to adopt an extraction or non-extraction approach in orthodontic treatment. In this lecture, the speaker will present a wide range of cases involving non-extraction and different selection of teeth for extraction cases. Ultimately the goals of treatment are to achieve an acceptable facial profile and an occlusion that is esthetic, functional and stable.

Dr Seah Tian Ee graduated from the National University of Singapore in 2000 with Bachelor of Dental Surgery. In 2005, he obtained the Masters in Dental Surgery (Oral Maxillofacial Surgery) and in the same year was made Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons. In 2008 he made Fellow of the Academy of Medicine, Singapore. A Consultant in the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, National Dental Centre Singapore, he has special interests in rhinoplasty, facial aesthetics as well as orthognathic surgery. He is also a visiting OMS Consultant to Orange Orthodontics & Dentofacial Deformities Clinic.



### **Topic: Facial Aesthetics for the Dental Patient**

Patients have always been aesthetically driven and the birth of the internet coupled with the explosion of information has allowed patients to engage in rapid exchange of ideas. Dental patients with skeletal discrepancies and malocclusion are not willing to settle for just functional remedies. Often, besides correcting their occlusion they may ask for other adjunctive procedures such as rhinoplasty to correct their nasal deformities. A wide range of procedures and surgeries is available for these patients. This talk will touch on orthognathic surgery, rhinoplasty and some anti aging techniques.

### **Topic: Management of Endodontic Complications**

With advancement in healthcare and extending life expectancy, our patients' oral awareness and expectations are also increasing. With the explosion of information on the Internet, our patients are more aware of their treatment options and more are looking towards options that help them keep their teeth for as long a possible. Dentists who practice endodontics on a regular basis would have encountered some form of endodontic complication and it would be very helpful to know how to managed them adequately when it occurs. In his lecture, Dr. Long will explore the various endodontic complications faced by dentists; starting from mis--diagnosis, to anesthetic failure; looking for the Calcified canals, preventing and managing perforations and dealing with the dreaded "broken" instrument.

## Dr. Rashid Tahir

Dr. Rashid Tahir graduated with BDS (Singapore) in 1994 and MSc (Distinction) in Children's Dentistry from the Eastman Dental Institute in 1998. He is an Adjunct Senior Lecturer at the Faculty of Dentistry, National University of Singapore. He maintains a private practice restricted to Pediatric dentistry at The Kids Dentist located at Camden Medical Centre, Singapore.

### **Topic 1: Pediatric dental emergencies at the general dentist's clinic**

Every dentist has a responsibility to provide emergency care to patients who are in need including children. Dental emergencies that children often present to the general dentists are either trauma to the primary or permanent dentition or pain and swellings. The management of these dental emergencies can be a challenge especially if the child is distressed and not cooperative. Fortunately, not all dental emergencies in children require immediate intervention. This presentation will discuss the common dental emergencies in children and methods to ease them in a general dental practice setting.

### **Topic 2: Handling the child patient in a general dental practice setting**

Children can be a handful especially when they have to sit still for long dental procedures. Yet, the dental team is expected to provide quality dental care for children in the dental office. Therefore, it is essential that children's behavior is appropriately handled to ensure good cooperation during the treatment. This presentation will cover simple practical tips on managing the child's behavior for dental treatment in the general dental practice setting.
